I also provide weekly psychotherapy with mostly adolescents and adults, coordinate and plan community / outreach programming, provide comprehensive psychological reports with detailed recommendations and an extensive feedback session, develop and deliver applied performance psychology interventions and mental skills training with a variety of local performers, conduct weekly supervision with practicum students, offer presentations and psychoeducational training materials to local communities and clinicians, and engage in ongoing consultation and collaboration with colleagues and other providers within the mental health field.
